Exhibit Framing

The exhibit framing consists of three parts — (1) metal pipes; (2) joint fittings; and (3) tie downs.

- 1. Pipes:** All pipes are 1.5" S40 galvanized steel cut in 16 feet 10 inch (16' 10") lengths. Each tri-pod requires twelve of these pipes. The galvanization process eliminates the possibility of rusting. Considering the weight of each pipe, I would suggest you shop locally to minimize the delivery cost. When last purchased, we paid \$7,300 for 192 sections; however, the price is highly sensitive to conditions in the steel market. You will probably find that they only come in a standard length of eighteen feet; however, we have always been able to get the supplier to cut them to our required 16' length.

- 2. Joint Fittings:** You will need four different pieces of fabricated galvanized fittings. Three of the pieces are used to connect the pipes and the fourth is a base which prevents each leg from digging into the earth. Each tripod requires:

The specifications for each piece are contained in the attached document titled "Fabricated Fittings." Photographs of each piece are also attached. With this information you should be able to get any fabrication company to make them. When we last purchased a set (100 each of the tees, ells & bases and 250 connectors), the price was \$14,982 without shipping. We purchased them locally at:

- 3. Tie Downs:** These are the yellow straps and anchors which secure each tripod to the ground. **Straps** are 2" x 24' (or longer) Ratchet Straps with long wide handle and wire hooks, yellow, 12K webbing. Each tripod requires three straps at about \$15 each. They are probably available at Home Depot or Lowes but we last purchased them at:

Anchors are 30 inches (or longer) x 3/4" 12-gauge long galvanized steel double head earth anchors - the same type as typically used to tie down mobile homes. They should be readily available, or at least order, at any Home Depot or Lowes. Each tripod needs one and the cost is about \$20 each.

NOTES:

1. I would budget \$300 to purchase miscellaneous parts such as washers, screws, hooks and other minor things needed during the set-up.
2. I would suggest ordering a several extra pieces of each items, especially the fabricated pieces, for replacement purposes.
3. Depending on the terrain, you may need one or more "leg extensions" which fit inside a leg and is used to level the tripod. We had our crew make those and if you think you might need them, I'll get you the information.

Exhibit Framing

The exhibit framing consists of three parts — (1) metal pipes; (2) joint fittings; and (3) tie downs.

- 1. Pipes:** All pipes are 1.5" S40 galvanized steel cut in 16 feet 10 inch (16' 10") lengths. Each tri-pod requires twelve of these pipes. The galvanization process eliminates the possibility of rusting. Considering the weight of each pipe, I would suggest you shop locally to minimize the delivery cost. When last purchased, we paid \$7,300 for 192 sections; however, the price is highly sensitive to conditions in the steel market. You will probably find that they only come in a standard length of eighteen feet; however, we have always been able to get the supplier to cut them to our required 16' length.

- 2. Joint Fittings:** You will need four different pieces of fabricated galvanized fittings. Three of the pieces are used to connect the pipes and the fourth is a base which prevents each leg from digging into the earth. Each tripod requires:

The specifications for each piece are contained in the attached document titled "Fabricated Fittings." Photographs of each piece are also attached. With this information you should be able to get any fabrication company to make them. When we last purchased a set (100 each of the tees, ells & bases and 250 connectors), the price was \$14,982 without shipping. We purchased them locally at:

- 3. Tie Downs:** These are the yellow straps and anchors which secure each tripod to the ground. **Straps** are 2" x 24' (or longer) Ratchet Straps with long wide handle and wire hooks, yellow, 12K webbing. Each tripod requires three straps at about \$15 each. They are probably available at Home Depot or Lowes but we last purchased them at:

Anchors are 30 inches (or longer) x 3/4" 12-gauge long galvanized steel double head earth anchors - the same type as typically used to tie down mobile homes. They should be readily available, or at least order, at any Home Depot or [owes. Each tripod needs one and the cost is about \$20 each.

NOTES:

1. I would budget \$300 to purchase miscellaneous parts such as washers, screws, hooks and other minor things needed during the set-up.
2. I would suggest ordering a several extra pieces of each items, especially the fabricated pieces, for replacement purposes.
3. Depending on the terrain, you may need one or more "leg extensions" which fit inside a leg and is used to level the tripod. We had our crew make those and if you think you might need them, I'll get you the information.
