WHEREAS, the National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives (NOBLE), a respected advocate for diversity and equity in law enforcement, is an official partner and supporter of the 30x30 Initiative, reinforcing its importance to advancing racial and gender equity in policing; and

WHEREAS, supporting the 30x30 Initiative aligns with the mission of the Ypsilanti Police Advisory Commission to promote equitable policing practices and improve police-community relations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ypsilanti City Council affirms its support for the 30x30 Initiative and encourages the Ypsilanti Police Department to adopt its principles, commit to its goals, and formally join as a participating agency;
